

Promoters Conditions

General

1. The promoter is 'Nova Centurion Swimming Club'
2. The meet will be held under the relevant ASA/FINA/IPC Laws and Technical Rules of Swimming.
3. The competition is open to ASA or other National Swimming Association registered swimmers only.

Entries

- 1) All meet information can be downloaded via the website www.novacenturion.co.uk
- 2) **Age as at 10th March 2019**
- 3) Entry times **must not** be faster than the published times. Times are long course 50m pool, conversions allowed. All entries must have a submitted time where one is not available from ASA Rankings. Warm up will be available before the start of each session.
- 4) **This Meet will be filled on a first come first served basis closing date on or before Friday 22nd February 2019.**
- 5) The preferred method of entry is using **SPORTSYSTEMS Entry Manager**. When using Entry Manager, the completed entry file is submitted by email and payment made by cheque or BACS.
- 6) Where a number of swimmers are entering from one club it is requested that one person coordinate the entries and submits one entry file.
- 7) Individual manual entries may be submitted by post or email. Please ensure you put adequate postage on posted entries. Envelopes with insufficient postage will not be collected from the Royal Mail delivery office.
- 8) Entries by post must include payment by cheque unless you have notified intention to pay by BACS. Payment must be made at the time of entry.
- 9) The entry fee is **£7.00** per swim.
- 10) **Summary Form must be sent by post or email.**
- 11) Notification of accepted entries shall be via a list on the website.
- 12) Refunds will not be given for withdrawn swimmers or for entry errors or omissions attributable to the individual or their club.
- 13) The promoter reserves the right to return any entry not fulfilling the above requirements.

NO LATE ENTRIES OR ENTRIES ON THE DAY WILL BE ACCEPTED

Events and Age Groups

- 14) Events are 50m & 100m all strokes (not IM), and 200IM
- 15) Age groups: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15/over
- 16) All events are heat declared winners. Awards will be presented to the top 3 placed swimmers in each age group.

The Competition

- 17) Heats shall be spearheaded.
- 18) It is the swimmers' responsibility to report to the Competitors' Stewards when their event is called, races will not wait for swimmers.
- 19) Over the top/side by side starts may be used at any time at the discretion of the lead referee.

Withdrawals

- 20) If a swimmer is unable to swim or simply wishes to withdraw then it is important to notify the recorders. Known withdrawals prior to the meet should be notified immediately by email to: meets@novacenturion.co.uk
No later than 6pm Saturday 9th March, start sheets will then be produced and be viewable via the website.
- 21) All other matters regarding the administration and running of this meet shall be decided by the promoter.
